The speakers, Mr. Michalopoulos and Mr. Plakogiannis, nephrologists at medialyse dialysis unit in Serres will present scientific viewpoints on the symptoms, the causes that lead to kidney failure as well as ways of early detection, prevention and effective treatment of Chronic Kidney Disease.
